Please see the following important updates:

FREIGHT RATES FROM CHINA

- Rates have started to drop coming into the first half of OCT as shipping lines try to fill their vessels before the holiday
 - There are talks of a GRI for second half of OCT of USD500 per 20GP and USD1000 per 40GP/HQ, however this is NOT CONFIRMED
- We are not sure if space will become tight again after the holidays in October but as always, we recommend you ship asap to ensure timely cargo arrival

QUEENSLAND PUBLIC HOLIDAY - King's Birthday

 On the 7th of October our office will be closed for the King's Birthday public holiday (QLD), our office will re-open on Tuesday 8th of October at 8.30am

CHINA HOLDIAYS – Factory Closures

o 1st October until the 7th October, returning to work on the 8th of October

US LONGSHOREMEN STRIKES (EAST COAST ONLY)

 East Coast Longshoremen have been striking the last few days due to a breakdown in negotiations with the United States Maritime Alliance

- As of today, an agreement has been reached between both parties to allow the recommencement of work tentatively until a final agreement can be reached
- Hopefully, the closure earlier this week will only have short term effects on sea cargo departing the US

AIRFREIGHT EX EUROPE

- Due to recent incidents (small package explosions on planes) across Europe some airlines are restricting cargo from UKNOWN SHIPPERS
 - Check with us before you book your next air freight shipment from Europe, and we will assist in finding you the best solution for your cargo

BMSB SEASON

- Has commenced
 - Started on 1st September 2024 and will run through until 30th April 2025 (inclusive)
 - Seasonal measures for Brown marmorated stink bug (BMSB) DAFF (agriculture.gov.au)

OTHER IMPORTANT POINTS

- o Detention
 - Make sure on CIF/CFR shipments that your suppliers are requesting the maximum number of free days upon arrival, to help avoid detention
- o Seaway Bills
 - Make sure you request a Seaway Ocean Bill from your supplier to avoid extra costs relating to document delays
